# Commissioning and Investment Update, February 24

The following briefing gives a quick update on key activity within the VCSE Commissioning and Investment Workstream, and opportunities for future involvement. Please get in touch with <u>Susie.wright@10gm.org.uk</u> for further details, or to join in any of our planned work.

## NHS Contracts Review

- A list of all NHS contracts held by VCSE in GM (including localities) has been created.
- Local Infrastructure Organisations have checked this list for completeness as far as practicable.
- The majority of MH contracts have now been reviewed.
- Community and non healthcare lists are to be reviewed at a locality level 10GM have chased up this activity, are asking that LIOs are included in these discussions and that 10GM are kept abreast of progress.
- Message shared with VCSE Hospital Discharge Alliance that additional hospital discharge funding (from NHS GM, to localities, for VCSE activity) has still not been confirmed post March 24.
- A briefing has been shared with sector to support smaller groups with negotiations.

### Social Value

- NHS GM and GMCA are exploring the concept of a social value brokerage portal which links up businesses with a social value offer, with VCSE organisations seeking funding or support.
- A joint session to develop the ask / model has been postponed to 14.3.24. Contact <u>Susie.wright@10gm.org.uk</u> if you would like to be involved.
- NHSE Anchors Event around Social Value held on 5.2.24. Lots of VCSE representation in the room. Discussions included brokerage and connection; and measuring impact.

# GMCA Fair Funding Protocol Implementation

- Work and skills team are re-writing policy / procedures to reflect FFP.
- A one-off task and finish group has met to collate examples challenges that the VCSE experience in contracting/ procurement these will be shared at the next FFP Implementation Group.
